Resolution Supporting the Constitution and the Proposition that all US Citizens are Equal Under the Law

WHEREAS, the Constitution is the basic law of the United States of America; and,

WHEREAS, the Constitution applies equally to all US citizens; and,

WHEREAS, under the Constitution there are no "second class" citizens; and,

WHEREAS, all individuals holding official offices in the US government or in each state government take an oath to support the Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, voting rights, privacy rights, religious rights, assembly rights, petition to redress grievances rights are long recognized as guaranteed by the Constitution;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Democratic National Committee (DNC) restates its commitment to and support of the United States Constitution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the DNC urges all Democratic candidates to recommit to supporting and defending the Constitution and the proposition that all US citizens are equal under the law.
